

After the placement process has concluded, you can view your placement score in your SIS account. After signing into your SIS account, you may view your placement score by clicking the "Academics" tab and choosing the "Test Scores" tab. Your placement corresponds to your score as follows:

1 = ENWR 1505/1506 sequence

2 = ENWR 1510, 1520, or 1530

3 = FWR+ course





- CLASS LEVEL (1000, 2000, 3000, AND 4000 LEVELS)


